

Following the success of the twelve previous IEAGHG Summer Schools we are pleased to announce the 2019 Summer School which will be held in **Regina, Canada** hosted by the International CCS Knowledge Centre from the **7th to the 12th July 2019**.

The summer school agenda is still in development but plans to be an intensive 5 day event which will commence the evening of Sunday 7th and conclude with a final dinner on Friday 12th July. The week will also include a visit to the Boundary Dam capture facility and Aquistore storage site.

To apply for a place at this prestigious CCS summer school please complete the application process below before the **Friday 15th of February 2019** (midnight GMT). Incomplete forms and applications will not be accepted. We will notify all applicants of our decision by early April 2019.

The application process will require: (please attach all three as PDFs)

- Letter of support from your supervisor (Max. 300 words)
- Current CV (Max. 1 page)
- Covering letter (Max. 600 words)

The letter of support from your supervisor should clearly state your English proficiency (a good level of spoken and written English is required) and qualities which make you an ideal candidate for the IEAGHG International Interdisciplinary CCS Summer School. The letter of support should emphasise how you will use what you have learnt at the Summer School when you return to your position. Please include your supervisors name, position and connection to you. (Max 300 words)

As a guide, your Curriculum Vitae (CV) should include: educational background (including university AND school qualifications), work history, conferences attended (if applicable), publications (if applicable), accolades and extracurricular activities.

Your letter of application provides you with the opportunity to stand out from all the other excellent international applications IEAGHG expects to receive this year. Explain to us why you should be selected for the 2019 IEAGHG CCS Summer School. Include your interest(s) in CCS, future career aspirations, what you feel you can bring to the Summer School. Most importantly, please explain how you will benefit from the Summer School and subsequently use and share what you have learnt. (Max 600 words).

All accommodation, meals and materials will be provided by the event sponsors and there are no fees associated with attendance. However, you will need to fund your own travel to the venue. **Please ensure you have access to funding to cover the cost of travel before submitting your application.**
