



Following the success of the seventeen previous IEAGHG International CCS Summer Schools, we are pleased to announce the 2026 Summer School which will be held in **Copenhagen, Denmark**, and hosted by the Innovations Mission for Carbon Capture, Utilisation, and Storage (INNO-CCUS) from the **28<sup>th</sup> June – 4<sup>th</sup> July 2026**.

The Summer School agenda is still in development but plans to be an intensive 5-day event which will commence the evening of Sunday 28<sup>th</sup> June and conclude with a final dinner on Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> July. The week will also include a field trip day.

### **HOW TO APPLY:**

To apply for a place at this prestigious CCS summer school please complete the application process below before **Monday 12<sup>th</sup> January 2025** (23:59 GMT). Incomplete forms and applications will not be accepted, and the application portal will close strictly at **23:59 GMT on Monday 12<sup>th</sup> January**. We will notify all applicants of our decision in early March 2026.

The application process will require you completing the applicant information form on the IEAGHG website (<https://ieaghg.org/summer-school>) AND uploading the three documents specified below. **Please attach all three as PDFs, and save each document starting with your SURNAME (i.e. 'SMITH\_Application', 'SMITH\_CV', 'SMITH\_Support')**. Please also note and adhere to the below restrictions on **length** of your supporting documentation:

1. **Letter of application** (Max. 600 words)
2. **Current CV** (Max. 1 page)
3. **Letter of support from your supervisor** (Max. 300 words)

Your **letter of application** provides you with the opportunity to stand out from all the other excellent international applications IEAGHG expects to receive this year. Explain to us why you should be selected for the 2026 IEAGHG CCS Summer School. Include your interest(s) in CCS, future career aspirations, what you feel you can bring to the Summer School. Most importantly, please explain how you will benefit from the Summer School and subsequently use and share what you have learnt. (Max 600 words)

As a guide, your **Curriculum Vitae (CV)** should include educational background (including university AND school qualifications), work history, conferences attended (if applicable), publications (if applicable), accolades and extracurricular activities. (Max. 1 page)

The **letter of support** from your supervisor should clearly state your English proficiency (a good level of spoken and written English is required) and qualities which make you an ideal candidate for the IEAGHG CCS Summer School. The letter of support should emphasise how you will use what you have learnt at the Summer School when you return to your position. Please include your supervisors name, position and connection to you. (Max 300 words)

All accommodation, meals and materials will be provided by the event sponsors and there are no fees associated with attendance. However, you will need to fund your own travel to the venue. **Please ensure you have access to funding to cover the cost of travel before submitting your application.**
